Student Eligibility

The SYEMC Youth Tour contest is open to any high school junior (rising senior) who resides in or attends school in the SYEMC service area. Homeschooled students are also eligible to apply if they reside within SYEMC's geographical service area. (Children of SYEMC employees and directors are not eligible.)

Application Content

- Signed copy of the completed 2025 Youth Tour Application.
- Brief written statement explaining why you wish to attend Youth Tour.
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, employer or other youth organization leader.
